



Installation Separate the upper and lower parts from the switch by screwdriver.</p>  <p>See the picture below</p> <p>(Note: Distinguish between each corresponding slot)</p>	<p>2b. With neutral wire version (Neutral wire is required on the switch) according to the following diagram wiring.</p> <p>1-Neutral wire. 2-Live wire. 3-Switch. 4.5.6.7-Lighting, They're between L1,L2,L3,L4 and Neutral wire.</p> 	<p>3. Fix the switch onto wall. 3.1 Put the switch lower parts into switch box in the wall. 3.2 Mount the two side screws. 3.3 Install the upper top case (install from up above). 3.4 Cover the upper top</p> 	<p>2 Basic Product Functions</p> <p>Voice control: The device can be controlled by voice through Alexa, Siri, Google Assistant, or other devices that have passed Matter certification</p> <p>App control: Device control can be achieved through Alexa, Apple Home, Google Home, SmartThings or other apps that have already solved the Matter SDK.</p> <p>Device reset: Press and hold the switch button for 10-12 seconds to reset, with the indicator light flashing 3 times to indicate a reset.</p> <p>Device pairing: There is a Matter QR code and an 11-digit short code on each device. To bind a device, you can use the matching App to scan the QR code or enter the 11-digit short code for pairing and binding.</p> <p>Paring window: There is a 15 minutes paring window after power on where the green LED is blinking, where the switch can't be paired after this time window expires. To restore paring, you need to power the switch down from the fuse box or do a device reset by holding the button for 10 seconds or more.</p>	<p>3 Add to Apple via Matter</p> <p>3.1 Check the environment</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Install the Google Home app. 2. Have a control hub that supports Matter, and any of the following devices will suffice: Nest Hub (2nd gen), Nest Hub Max, Nest WiFi, Nest WiFi Pro <p>5.2 App Distribution Network</p> <p>Step 1: Launch your Google Home App and tap "+".</p> <p>Step 2: Choose "Set up device" and tap "New device" to add a new device.</p> <p>Step 3: Choose Matter and tap "Yes" on the confirming page.</p> <p>Step 4: Scan the setup QR code on your device.
